WHEREAS, the Project is funded by FEMA and the Town is looking to bid the construction of the pre-cast culvert structure, and;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF TAYLOR AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town Board of the Town of Taylor authorizes Lamont Engineers to request bids for the precast culvert structure for the Project and authorizes the Town Supervisor to execute any documents regarding the project bidding.
