Prior to the meeting the councilmen were given the chance to read and review November 2017 meeting minutes and also time to review and sign general and highway fund vouchers.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Robert Bittner from Tompkins Trust Company presented to the board some options on retirement for the Highway Department.

His recommendation was to go with a S.I.M.P.L.E. (Savings Incentive Match Plan for Employees) Plan. It is an IRA. Anytime from January 1 - October 1 it can be opened. This is a match plan that the town would have to either match each employee up to 3% for at least 3 out of 5 years or could just do a 2% annual contribution. The cost is \$10.00 per employee to set up. He likes to use American Funds for many reasons. The target date fund is based on the employee's age. This is the upfront cost and a low operating plan. The employee is vested from day one. A 401k is typically between \$1,500.00-\$2,000.00 just to get started and then annual costs. The town is able to choose who is eligible to take advantage of the plan. It is all done online by the payroll department for the contributions, by both the town and the employee. 3% would be the maximum that the town would have to match.

DISCUSSION:

- Retirement Need to decide if going to do this for just the highway department or for all employees.
- Meeting attendance is important.
- THOMA plan from last meeting The grant writing would cost the town \$6,000.00 with no guarantee. Discussions if the board wants to take that risk with that much money.
- Sprague Insurance Company will be at the January meeting to go over the town's coverage. Shared work contracts need to be used. If we have a claim, the insurance company will fight it without the contracts being signed.
- Fire Contract Jaymie had no luck getting ahold of Cincinnatus Clerk for a copy of the Fire District budget. Going to have to sit down and talk with them at some point. There are a couple of things they are not doing and we are paying for a service. Was not able to get the KNOX boxes for our buildings since the Fire Department has not completed their end of the paperwork, at least 2 dry hydrants that we know of are broken and not able to be used, 1 on Factory Drive and 1 on Pudney Road. Also, there have been 3 fires now in Taylor that Mike has not been notified. After the last one he took a copy of the law down to the Fire Chief and gave it to him. Still no notification. Any structure fire, code enforcement needs to be notified.
- Larry Fitts submitted his contract for the reassessment. Suggestion of having the town
 attorney take a look at it before it is signed. In the contract it says that all mailing cost
 and labor is on the town. Nothing was said about that at the last meeting. This is an
 added cost on top of the amount he gave last month. Bryce will call him and see if he will
 do away with that part of the contract, if yes, all agreed to sign it at next meeting.
- Have not received any project bids yet for the building on Town Line Road. Jaymie will have the Cortland Standard run it for one week.
- The Planning Board asked for a comprehensive plan, Bryce thought there was a copy in his office but he can't locate it.
- NYSEG has brought the poles through by the salt shed but no wires yet. The power will be more accessible when we need it for the new building now.
- The boilers at both buildings need to be cleaned. Riley will schedule that when the contractor comes to look at the 3 rooms that need heat.
- The smoke alarms seem to be working fine now.
- Need a coal delivery. Chris will call for it.
- Dog licenses Need an enumeration done. Will check with Sprague next month about insurance coverage for whoever does it. So many dogs not licensed.
